

## WIFI 5GHZ & 2.4GHZ SIGNAL OUTPUT

Firstly, this will only work if the Wi-Fi hub sends a signal which is both 2.4ghz & 5ghz.

1) Log onto the back end of your Wi-Fi provider (webpage or app used to manage your HUB/Router)

2) Locate the section which mentions 2.4ghz and 5ghz section.

3) Now the Wi-Fi hub will have the same name for both 2.4ghz and 5ghz

4) You need to separate the 2 out

5) Set the 2.4ghz hub name to be \*Your router/hub name\*

6) Set the 5ghz hub name \* Your router/hub name\*1 (add a character or number something to identify the different Wi-Fi network names)

7) This then separates the 2 networks out and shows them as 2 Wi-Fi networks

8) Follow the Wi-Fi troubleshooting on how to connect your phone to your controller.

9) Go back onto the hub manager page and set both the 2.4ghz and 5ghz to have the same Wi-Fi network name.

10) As your Wi-Fi controller will already be connected to your Wi-Fi hub this will not matter if the 2.4ghz and 5ghz are on the same Wi-Fi network.
